The Anoka County District Court and Anoka County will host an Open Courthouse event on April 26, 2019

The Open Courthouse event will feature legal service clinics available to area residents. Service clinics will help residents to:

- Resolve outstanding warrants for criminal misdemeanors and gross misdemeanors, and discuss resolution of outstanding issues in some felony cases;
- Talk to officials from the Minnesota DPS Division of Driver and Vehicle Services about reinstating a suspended driver's license;
- Begin the process of expunging adult, juvenile, and eviction court records;
- Discuss family law issues, obtain legal documents and court forms, and obtain a court date; and
- Discuss civil, guardianship, conservatorship, or general probate and estate planning issues. Obtain legal documents and court forms.
