

FORFEITED VEHICLE RELEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into on 5/16, 2017, between the Metropolitan Airports Commission and [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Airports Commission is in possession of the following vehicle which was acquired through a forfeiture proceeding pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 169A.63, the DWI forfeiture law:

Stat. § 169A.63 via Certified Mail on May 6, 2017, and BMO Harris Bank, N.A., lien holder of the above-referenced vehicle, was served with a Notice of Seizure and Intent to Forfeit Vehicle pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 169A.63 via Certified Mail on May 5, 2017.

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] registered owner, has requested that the Metropolitan Airports Commission release the vehicle.


NOW THEREFORE, in the interests of promoting public safety and the prevention of further economic waste, the Metropolitan Airports Commission and [REDACTED] agree as follows:

1. [REDACTED] agrees to pay the MAC the sum of \$500.00. Payment shall be made to the attorney for the MAC, via certified funds made payable to Metropolitan Airports Commission, within ten (10) days of the date of signature by [REDACTED] on this Agreement. The vehicle will not be released before full payment occurs. This payment includes all towing and administrative charges on the above-referenced vehicle.
2. In consideration of this Agreement, the parties, for themselves, their employees, officers, officials, agents, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns, hereby release and discharge their employees, officers, officials, agents, representatives, predecessors, successors, attorneys and assigns of and from any

and all claims, damages, demands, actions, causes of actions or suits of law or equity of whatsoever kind or nature that each of them may have against the other, whether known or unknown, arising out of claims which were or might be alleged in the matter referred to above in connection with the above described vehicle and its seizure by the Metropolitan Airports Commission.


3. This release agreement is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the successors and assigned parties.
